II.	Open burning shall be deemed to be allowed with a p		shall be deemed to be allowed with a permit only for the following:
	A.	For re	For recreation, camping or a cookout:
		i.	Only dry, clean wood products or other clean-burning fuels are burned;
		ii.	Only smokeless fuels, if any, are used to start the fire;
		iii.	The pile of material being burned is 3 feet in diameter or less, and 2 feet or less in height;
		iv.	The fire is a minimum of twenty five feet (25 ft.) from any structure or combustible material.
		v.	The fire is a minimum of fifteen feet (15 ft.) from any inhabited area, roadway, property line, utility;
		vi.	Portable outdoor fireplaces shall be used in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and shall not be operated within (15 ft.) of a structure or combustible material.
		vii.	The fire is to be constantly attended at all times until the fire is extinguished;
		viii.	Adequate means to control & extinguish the open fire shall be readily available at all times during any burning;
		ix.	A class 4A fire extinguisher or garden hose shall be close to the fire;
		х.	A barbeque grill needs no permit.
III.	The permit holder is responsible for leaving a message with the O'Hara Township Police Secretary, or on the Township voice mail system at 412-782-1403 a minimum of one hour prior to igniting the recreational fire to report that he/she is having a permitted recreational fire.		
IV.	All applications shall be submitted to the Fire Marshal or his designee, Township of O'Hara, 325 Fox Chapel Road, Pittsburgh, PA 15238.
