I. OPENING PROCEDURES

Manager Jakubec noted virtual meeting procedures.

II. PUBLIC COMMENTS CONCERNING THE PROPOSED YEAR 2022 TOWNSHIP BUDGET

Manager Jakubec stated the purpose of the public hearing is to receive public comment from residents and others regarding the proposed 2022 Township budget. As proposed, the budget contains a real estate tax rate of 2.1 mils, which is the same millage as in 2021; earned income and realty transfer taxes also remain the same. Council reviewed the budget document in November and it is scheduled for adoption during the December 14<sup>th</sup> Regular meeting.
